		 Changing schools greatly impedes students' academic and social growth. 		
		 After determining that a student is living in a temporary housing situation, a housing questionnaire is provided to the parent/youth to be completed. 		
		 When transitioning a student to a new school, the McKinney-Vento liaison should consider the timing of the school year. 		
		7. When enrolling a student living in temporary housing, you should not share that information with other staff due to FERPA regulations.		
		8. A student experiencing homelessness must be immediately enrolled in school but waits until immunization records are received prior to attending classes.
